Many urologists are involved in the treatment of children with kidney infections, congenital hernias, undescended testicles and a variety of other straightforward conditions.

A few urologists undergo additional training to become highly-specialised paediatric urologists; they are trained to deal with more complex, childhood urological conditions such as **hypospadias**, **bladder reconstruction** and **renal tumours** (such as Wilm's tumours).
